### Organist Julie M. Ford in Recital

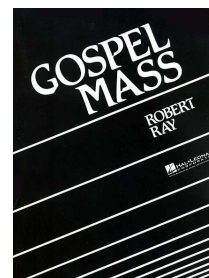


**Sunday, March 27, 4:30 pm**
